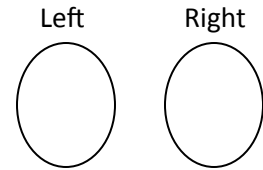

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.

WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND CONSENT FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT (the "Agreement").

NATIONAL SPORTS CENTER FOR THE DISABLED ("NSCD") WINTER PROGRAM

"Adult" means the undersigned Adult, being at least 18 years old, signing on behalf of him/herself and/or the undersigned parent(s) or legal guardian(s), being at least 18 years old, signing on behalf of the minor child or protected person named below ("Protected Person") so that the Protected Person or Adult will be permitted to engage in the Activity. "Participant" refers to the person taking part in the NSCD Winter Program. Adult and Protected Person shall collectively be referred to hereinafter as the "Undersigned". Undersigned understand and agree that skiing, snowboarding and/or any other activities or programs or use of the facilities or equipment (collectively hereinafter the "Activity") of the NSCD and Winter Park Resort ("Resort") can be **HAZARDOUS**. Undersigned understand and agree the following applies whenever Participant uses the NSCD's or Resort's facilities or services. **The Undersigned understand and agree that Participant will not be permitted to take part in an Activity unless this Agreement is fully executed.**

UNDERSIGNED ACKNOWLEDGES, UNDERSTANDS, AND AGREES THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT UNDERSIGNED IS ASSUMING RISKS, WAVY RIGHTS, AND RELEASING CLAIMS, AND THAT THIS AGREEMENT WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT AND APPLY FOR EVERY DAY PARTICIPANT ENGAGES IN ANY ACTIVITY WITHOUT REQUIRING A NEW AGREEMENT TO BE SIGNED FOR EACH DAY, SEASON, OR YEAR, UNTIL A NEW RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND WAIVER OF LEGAL RIGHTS IS EXECUTED OR THIS AGREEMENT IS REVOKED IN WRITING AND THAT WRITING IS ACCEPTED IN WRITING, SIGNED BY THE NSCD'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE. Undersigned are advised, understand and agree that under Colorado law any person using a ski area for the purpose of skiing, which includes, without limitation, sliding downhill or jumping on snow or ice on skis, a toboggan, a sled, a tube, a snowbike, a snowboard or any other device; or for the purpose of using any of the facilities of a ski area, including but not limited to ski slopes and trails is considered a "skier" and, further, that Colorado law provides that a skier using the facilities of a ski area assumes certain "inherent dangers and risks of skiing" as defined in the Colorado Ski Safety Act (the "Act"). **IN ADDITION ADULT ACKNOWLEDGES, UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, ADULT FOR HIM/HERSELF AND, IF APPLICABLE, ON BEHALF OF PROTECTED PERSON, IS VOLUNTARILY ASSUMING ALL DANGERS AND RISKS OF SKIING, INHERENT OR OTHERWISE, AND IS WAIVING RIGHTS, AND RELEASING CLAIMS IN CONNECTION WITH DANGERS AND RISKS ABOVE AND BEYOND THOSE ADDRESSED BY THE ACT.**

Colorado law imposes on all skiers the obligation to maintain control at all times while skiing or when in an Activity and the Undersigned assume the responsibility of explaining the obligation to Protected Person and accept the responsibility of Protected Person maintaining control at all times while skiing or when involved in any Activity, with such assistance as NSCD or any other responsible person caring for the Protected Person may offer Protected Person. Adult agrees to read and to have Protected Person read, and if necessary, explain to Protected Person, all posted signs and warnings including instructions on use of lifts and equipment and Undersigned agree that Participant will obey those signs and warnings located on the property or at any facility or premise of NSCD or the Resort as either read by or explained to Participant and that Participant will obey and follow instructions from NSCD or Resort staff to the extent that it is possible for Participant to do so. Undersigned understand and agree that Participant must have the physical dexterity and knowledge, with such assistance as the NSCD may offer, to safely load, ride and unload the lifts. Undersigned assume the risks of Participant riding the lifts and engaging in any Activity accessible from the lifts and understand that participation in an instructional program does not eliminate the inherent risks of skiing or riding lifts. **Adult understands and agrees that Participant will or may be using ski lifts without an instructor or other adult except in cases where Protected Person requires assistance from an instructor or other adult to use lifts, and that the Participant may be entering into and using the freestyle terrain features contained in terrain parks. PARTICIPATION IN THE NSCD WINTER PROGRAM DOES NOT AND CANNOT ELIMINATE THE DANGERS AND RISKS OF SKIING OR USING SKI LIFTS.**

Undersigned understand and agree that the use of the ski area facilities involves risks including but not limited to high elevation, wildlife encounters, falling trees and limbs, marked and unmarked obstacles, deep snow conditions and tree wells, slick or uneven walking surfaces, surfaces covered with ice and snow, unstable ice and snow including but not limited to slides and avalanches, rugged mountainous terrain, acts of other skiers, collisions with snowmobiles, snowmaking and snow-grooming equipment, or other vehicles or equipment and equipment malfunction. Undersigned understand and agree that there are risks involved in decision-making and conduct of NSCD or Resort employees or volunteers involved with an Activity, including, but not limited to, the risks involved with rescue operations and/or medical care conducted by Resort personnel inside or outside of Resort boundaries, the risks associated with decisions made by Resort personnel to open and/or close terrain, and the risk that an instructor/guide/coach may misjudge weather, trail conditions, route/terrain selection, or some aspect of Participant's abilities, conditioning, mental, emotional or physical condition that may make a certain portion of the Activity appropriate or inappropriate for the Participant. Undersigned also understand and agree that there are risks involved with storing and/or leaving ski equipment at the Resort and that NSCD and Resort shall not be responsible for any loss of or damage to Undersigned's equipment. Undersigned understand and agree that participating in the Activity is **HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVES THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY OR DEATH. RECONGNIZING AND ACCEPTING THE RISKS, ADULT VOLUNTARILY CHOOSES TO TAKE PART IN THE ACTIVITY OR VOLUNTARILLY CHOOSES TO ALLOW PROTECTED PERSON TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ACTIVITY.**

Undersigned agree not to enter a "CLOSED" area and understand that entering or skiing in a "CLOSED" area is illegal and more dangerous to Participant and others than skiing in open areas of the ski area. Undersigned agree to inspect before use all equipment offered for use by the NSCD or Resort including, but not limited to, rental ski or snowboard, boots and bindings, ice skates, snowshoes, tubing equipment, exercise equipment or any other equipment (the "Equipment") and ask questions of NSCD or Resort's employees if Participant does not fully understand how to use either the Equipment or Resort's facilities. Undersigned warrant that information provided to rental and ski/board school technicians and personnel will be accurate and complete. **Adult understands and agrees that he/she may not be available or present when the Protected Person's Equipment is fitted and adjusted and hereby waives the opportunity to verify the helmet size and fit and binding settings and authorizes employees of the NSCD or Resort, other than the technician performing the fitting and adjusting, to verify the helmet size and fit and binding settings.** Undersigned understand and agree that, although Participant may be wearing a helmet, **a helmet cannot guarantee Participant's safety and no helmet can protect the wearer against all potential head injuries or prevent injury to the wearer's face, neck or spinal cord. Undersigned understand and agree that bindings may not release at all times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury or death. It is not possible to predict every situation in which bindings will release. In snowboarding, cross-country skiing, telemark skiing, snowblading, ski biking, ski boarding, and the use of some types of adaptive equipment including mono skis, dual skis, and foot skis used in ski biking, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use. These bindings may not be designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.** Undersigned accept for use "AS IS" any Equipment Participant uses for an Activity and to return either before use, or promptly after discovery, for replacement or repair any Equipment believed by Participant to be damaged or defective in any way. Adult accepts full responsibility for the care of the Equipment used for an Activity and agrees that Adult will be responsible for the replacement at full retail value of any Equipment damaged or not returned.

By signing this Agreement, Adult on his/her own behalf and, if applicable, on behalf of Protected Person acknowledges the risks and dangers associated with an Activity and the use of the facilities of the Resort generally and, as a condition to Participant engaging in any Activity and agrees to (1) ASSUME ANY AND ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH to Participant resulting from participation in any Activity; (2) WAIVE, RELEASE, and NOT SUE, MAKE ANY CLAIMS OR FILE ANY ACTIONS against the NSCD, Intrawest/Winter Park Operations Corporation, Winter Park Recreational Association, the City and County of Denver, Alterra Mountain Company, the United States, Winter Park Village Company Master Association, Inc., and each of their insurance carriers, subsidiaries, affiliates, officers, directors, shareholders, members, representatives, assignees, employees, volunteers and agents, as well as any Activity sponsors and Equipment manufacturers and distributors (hereinafter the "Indemnified Parties") that are based on, arise or result from, in whole or in part, participation in any Activity; (3) INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD THE INDEMNIFIED PARTIES HARMLESS, from any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, losses or liabilities whatsoever arising from or related to participation in any Activity and any loss, damage or injury, including death, that may be sustained by Participant or caused to others or their property by Participant. Undersigned agree to pay all costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees and disbursements, incurred by any Indemnified Party in defending an investigation, claim or suit brought by or on behalf of Undersigned.

Undersigned understand and agree that the operator of a venue for an Activity shall have the right to confiscate or revoke the privileges conferred by a ticket/pass where in the sole judgment of its representative Participant: 1) acts in any manner that endangers or may endanger the safety of Participant or any other person; 2) violates the law; 3) provides ski lessons, guided tours or related services for compensation without express authorization; 4) engages in misconduct or creates a nuisance; 5) violates "Your Responsibility Code"; 6) skis recklessly (high speed, jumping or tucking, out of control or straight down a run) – when skiing Participant must avoid other skiers, trail groomers, maintenance vehicles or objects below them; 7) skis on closed trails or in closed terrain; 8) is impaired by or uses alcohol or drugs; 9) uses abusive language (swearing or cursing); or 10) displays poor or unsafe etiquette including skiing at speeds higher than rest of traffic on a trail. Some of these acts may also be prosecuted as a criminal offense. A ticket/pass is NOT TRANSFERABLE and CANNOT BE RESOLD. A ticket/pass may be confiscated with no re-issue, if in the sole judgment of a representative of the Resort, it is used in a fraudulent, reckless or dangerous manner. Re-issued passes may be subject to a replacement fee. Undersigned acknowledges their affirmative duty to immediately notify the Resort if Participant's ticket/pass is lost or stolen.

Adult authorizes the NSCD and Resort and/or their authorized personnel to call for medical care, treatment and/or procedures (collectively "Care"), for Participant or to transport Participant to a medical facility or hospital if, in the opinion of such personnel, medical attention is needed. Adult agrees that upon Participant's transport to a facility or hospital that the NSCD, Resort and their personnel shall not have any further responsibility for Participant. Adult also consents to the Care given by an emergency caregiver or under the instructions and directions of a licensed physician. Adult knowingly and voluntarily consents in advance to such Care to encourage the physicians and the NSCD and Resort to exercise their best judgment in undertaking such Care. Further, Adult agrees on behalf of Adult and Protected Person to pay all costs associated with such Care and transportation provided for Participant and to indemnify and hold harmless the Indemnified Parties from any resulting costs.

Undersigned give the NSCD and Resort permission to take and use photographs and video of Participant taken during an Activity and use and sublicense such material for any purpose in promoting the NSCD, the Resort or related activities of the NSCD or Resort in print, brochures, advertisements, films and on broadcast presentations of any sort.

In consideration for participating in the Activity, Adult agrees for him/herself and Protected Person that ALL claims arising from or related to any Activity, including for injury to person or property and/or death shall be **GOVERNED BY COLORADO LAW, without regard to conflicts of law principles**, and that **EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION** shall be in the **District Court in Grand County, Colorado or in Federal Court for the District of Colorado**. **UNDERSIGNED VOLUNTARILY AND IRREVOCABLY WAIVE ANY OBJECTION TO SUCH LAW AND JURISDICTION.**

This Agreement shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be enforceable. **THE UNDERSIGNED PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN REPRESENTS AND ACKNOWLEDGES THAT HE/SHE IS ENTITLED TO AND IS SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF PROTECTED PERSON AND THAT PROTECTED PERSON WILL BE BOUND BY ALL THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.** UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT IF THIS AGREEMENT IS NOT SIGNED ON BEHALF OF PROTECTED PERSON, PROTECTED PERSON WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY. This Agreement shall be binding upon Undersigned's assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives.

ADULT HAS CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT, UNDERSTANDS IT AND SIGNS ON BEHALF OF HIM/HERSELF AND, IF APPLICABLE, PROTECTED PERSON WITH FULL KNOWLEDGE OF ITS SIGNIFICANCE BY SIGNING BELOW AND/OR ACCEPT IT BY USE OF THE ACTIVITY.
