Evaluations can help determine whether your child may benefit from accommodations or remediation support and may be used as a resource for an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 plan in an educational setting. Evaluations can also help to determine if your child may be talented and gifted, as well as to diagnose Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Specific Learning Disabilities (SLD), Autism Spectrum Disorders and Mood Disorders.

Benefits of a multidisciplinary approach

Multidisciplinary assessment teams offer the most comprehensive insights for you and your child and provide a depth of knowledge and information that would normally have to be obtained through separate evaluations. Our multidisciplinary team consists of licensed clinical and school psychologists, speech and language pathologists, and occupational therapists, all of whom work with students to treat a wide range of learning challenges. The team produces an individualized, cohesive report with results and recommendations for home, school and the greater community.



EVALUATIONS

ACHIEVEMENT

Assesses your child's reading, math and writing abilities

AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER (ASD)

Includes a full psychoeducational evaluation, as well as speech/language and occupational therapy assessments to determine the presence of ASD symptoms

COGNITIVE

Assesses verbal and nonverbal abilities, as well as working memory and processing speed

FULL OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Examines fine and gross motor skills, as well as possible sensory needs

HANDWRITING/FINE MOTOR ONLY

Assesses handwriting and fine motor abilities

LANGUAGE EVALUATION

Assesses receptive and expressive language abilities, as well as articulation

PSYCHOEDUCATIONAL

Provides a full assessment cognitive, achievement and social/emotional behaviors to aid in diagnosing specific learning disabilities or challenges that make learning difficult (e.g., ADHD, anxiety, executive functioning)

SPEECH/ARTICULATION

Evaluates production of speech sounds

Depending on the unique learning style and age of your child, the assessment may require several sessions. After testing, we will schedule a personal meeting to review the results of the evaluation and provide you with a detailed written report and specific recommendations.
